Swelling around the gums, jaw, or face may indicate an infection that requires immediate professional evaluation.

- Keep it moist in milk or saliva.
- Seek dental care immediately.

For a cracked or broken tooth:

- Rinse your mouth with warm water.
- Save any broken tooth fragments if possible.
- Avoid chewing on the injured side.
- Apply a cold compress to reduce swelling.

For severe tooth pain:

- Rinse with warm salt water.
- Avoid placing aspirin directly on the gums.
- Contact a dental office as soon as possible.
